- 1. Lane Conditions: The tournament will be bowled on a house shot. This is a scratch tournament.
- 2. Qualifying: Each entrant will bowl five (5) games, skipping lanes after each game. Lanes will be assigned by tournament committee.
- 3. Ties for the last qualifying spot will be broken by a one game roll-off.
- 4. Qualifying pins totals carry over to match play. Will qualify eight (8) bowlers to match play with a minimum of 20 bowlers.
- 5. Match play: Qualifiers will bowl five (5) games of match play with the fifth game being position round. Pin count from qualifying will carry over to match play. Bowlers will receive a bonus of 30 pins for a win, 15 pins for a tie and 0 for a loss.
- 6. Stepladder: Top three (3) will make it to step ladder. Any tie(s) for 3rd place will be a one game roll-off. Ties during the stepladder matches will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll-off.
- 7. Tournament Alternate: There will be one alternate based on qualifying. If the alternate is requested to enter the event, they will enter with their qualifying pin total plus the actual pin fall of the bowler they are replacing. (Bonus pins will not be added to the alternate's score for games they did not bowl).
- 8. Behavior: Abuse of equipment, foul or disruptive language, excessive yelling, and/or unprofessional behavior by bowlers or spectators are cause for the non-refundable dismissal from participation or attendance at this tournament.
