Eligibility: Open to all Greater Jackson USBC Youth sanctioned bowlers born after August 1, 2007, under the jurisdiction of the Greater Jackson USBC Youth. USBC National Youth sanctioning \$11. Local sanctioning can be obtained by paying \$6 local dues, if sanctioned outside of Greater Jackson USBC.

Entry Fee: **\$40.00** (includes qualifying & match play)

ENTRIES CLOSE: Sunday, November 9, 2025 @ 8:00 am.

Time: Sunday – November 9, 2025, @ 8:00 am – Both King's and Queen's

Format: This is a scratch tournament (all competition based on actual pin fall). Each entrant will bowl 5 games. The number of qualifiers will depend on the number of entries as defined in rule 2 under the rules and regulations section of the entry form.

Awards: 1st place – Jr. Queen & King – Trophy & Scholarship points
2nd place – Both Divisions – Trophy & Scholarship points
3rd & 4th place – Both Divisions – Medals & Scholarship points
5th place thru last qualifier – Both Divisions – Medals (if needed)
Scholarship points based on number of entries

Rules and Regulations

This tournament will be governed and sanctioned by USBC Youth Rules plus the following:

1. All bowlers must be sanctioned and be a member of the Greater Jackson USBC Youth. Membership cards must be shown at time of check-in. High School bowlers are not sanctioned through high school and must pay sanctioning if they do not bowl local youth leagues.
2. Five (5) games of qualifying will be bowled, moving pairs of lanes to the right after each game TBD and will cover the house. The top 4 girls & boys (depending on the # of entries, based on minimum 1:5 ratio) will advance to single elimination bracket format.
3. If a tie exists for the last position, an immediate 3-frame roll-off will take place on the pair of lanes determined by the tournament director(s). If a tie still exists, a 4th and 5th frame will be bowled. The frames will be bowled on the same lanes. This procedure will be followed until the tie is broken.
4. Bracket format for both boys and girls will be 1 game total pins to advance to next round.
5. Lane assignments will be determined by draw at time of check in. Please check in one-half hour prior to qualifying time. Tardy bowlers will receive zero pins and shall begin play with the score counting beginning with the frame and game then being bowled.
6. Single elimination will begin immediately following qualifying.
7. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to settle disputes not covered by USBC Youth.
8. Oil pattern will be determined by tournament director.

Spectators are not allowed in the bowler area.
