Eligibility: Open to all Greater Jackson USBC Youth sanctioned bowlers born after August 1, 2007, under the jurisdiction of the Greater Jackson USBC Youth. USBC National Youth sanctioning \$11. Local sanctioning can be obtained by paying \$6 local dues, if sanctioned outside of Greater Jackson USBC.

Entry Fee: **\$40.00** (includes qualifying & match play)

ENTRIES CLOSE: Saturday, March 7, 2026 @ 1:00 pm.

Qualifying: Saturday – March 7th, 2026, @ 1:00 pm

Matchplay: Sunday – March 8th, 2026, @ 9:00 am

Format: All competition based on actual pinfall. Each entrant will bowl five (5) games. The number of qualifiers (for both boys and girls) will depend on the number of entries. The boys and girls will **NOT** be competing against each other. Oil pattern is determined by Tournament director.

Awards: 1st place – Both Divisions – Trophy & Scholarship points
2nd place – Both Divisions – Trophy & Scholarship points
3rd & 4th place – Both Divisions – Medals & Scholarship points
5th place thru last qualifier – Both Divisions – Medals (if needed)
Scholarship points based on number of entries

Rules and Regulations

This tournament will be governed and sanctioned by USBC Youth Rules plus the following:

1. All bowlers must be sanctioned and be a member of the Greater Jackson USBC Youth. Membership cards must be shown at time of check-in. High School bowlers are not sanctioned through high school and must pay sanctioning if they do not bowl local youth leagues.
2. Five (5) games of qualifying will be bowled, moving pairs of lanes to the right after each game TBD and will cover the house. The top 4 girls & boys (depending on the # of entries, based on minimum 1:5 ratio) will advance to match play. Stepladders will begin immediately following completion of match play.
3. If a tie exists for the last position, an immediate roll-off will take place on the pair of lanes determined by the tournament director(s). Bowlers will draw for a starting lane and the bowler on the odd lane will start. If a tie still exists at the end of the game, a complete 9th and 10th frame will be bowled. The frames will be bowled on the same lanes. This procedure will be followed until the tie is broken.
4. The match play will consist of 6 one-game matches. The scoring in match play will be based on a 30-point bonus system. 30 bonus point will be awarded to the winner of each match. In the case of a tie, each bowler will be awarded 15 bonus points.
5. The 6th game will be a position round with the pairing determined by total points through 5 games.
6. If a tie exists after the 5th game, determination for the lane assignments before the position round will be determined by 1) best win/loss record: 2) high game rolled during match play: 3) a 3-frame roll-off.
7. Lane assignments will be determined by draw at time of check in. Please check in one-half hour prior to qualifying time. Tardy bowlers will receive zero pins and shall begin play with the score counting beginning with the frame and game then being bowled.
8. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to settle disputes not covered by USBC Youth.
9. In the event of a tie in any head-to-head (stepladder) competition, a 9th and 10th frame roll off will be done on the same lanes, until the tie is broken.

Spectators are not allowed in the bowler area.
