Rules and Regulations

This tournament will be governed and sanctioned by USBC Youth Rules plus the following:

- All bowlers must be sanctioned and be a member of the Greater Jackson USBC Youth. Membership cards must be shown at time of check-in. High School bowlers are not sanctioned through high school and must pay sanctioning if they do not bowl local youth leagues.
- 2. Three (3) games for doubles and three (3) for singles will be bowled with handicap, on the same pair of lanes. Doubles may consist of all boys, all girls or mixed boy/girl.
- 3. Bowlers will use highest 2024-25 yearbook average. If no average from last year, current average, with minimum of 9 games may be used and a current league standing sheet must accompany entry form. If this year's average is ten (10) pins or higher (minimum of 9 games) than last year, the higher average MUST be used. If no average from last year or not enough games for this year, participant will bowl scratch. High School averages do not count as they are not sanctioned through the USBC.
- 4. Handicap of 90% of 210 will be used.
- 5. All prizes will be awarded in the form of trophies or plaques.
- 6. This Tournament will be governed by USBC Youth Rules.
- 7. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to settle disputes not covered by USBC Youth Rules.
- 8. Bowlers have the option of bowling both doubles and singles (6 games) on the same squad where doubles will be bowled in the first three (3) games and singles will follow the next three (3) games or bowl doubles and singles on separate squads. Indicate on entry preferred squad, note same on singles if same squad is requested as doubles.

Spectators are not allowed in the bowler area.
